Run or Walk 5 miles, 2 miles, or ½ mile to raise awareness and funds for the global and local fight against human trafficking, forced childhood prostitution, and bonded slavery.

The Just Us event is sponsored by area businesses and individuals who have recognized the need to respond to this serious and often hidden problem. Many of us have only a vague awareness of terms like human trafficking or bonded slavery, but these industries are thriving around the world, and sometimes even in our own backyards. Proceeds will benefit the International Justice Mission (www.ijm.org), an international organization of law enforcement professionals, lawyers, social workers and recovery workers who are on the front lines, fighting for social justice in developing countries.

The Events: The 5-mile event starts at 6:00 p.m. at Owen Park, near the playground. It heads south on the bike trail and merges onto Putnam Trail near the UWEC campus. It is an out and back. The 2 mile fun-run/walk begins at 7:00 p.m. and will be an out and back along the bike trail as well, but heading north and going through Phoenix Park. The ½ mile kids race is an out and back from the Owen Park playground to the tennis courts. Water stops will be provided, as will post-run beverages and snacks. There will be activities for children available in the park, and families are encouraged to attend together for an evening of fitness, increasing awareness, and expressing gratitude for the freedoms we often take for granted. Music will also be provided in the band-shell following the runs.

Awards: There will be awards given for top finishers in each of 6 age categories for the 5-mile run, the 2-mile event, and for 3 age categories in the ½ mile kid's run. Runners and walkers, as well as families with young children are encouraged to participate.

Registration: Registration forms can be downloaded from our website, www.cvjusticerun.org or from www.indianheadtc.org. They can also be picked up at any sponsor location, as well as Fleet Feet on Water Street. Same day registration is available, but 2010 T-shirts are guaranteed only for those who are pre-registered. Registration deadline is July 7th. Please make checks payable to International Justice Mission, and recognize that this is a charitable contribution for which you will receive a tax-deductible receipt in the mail in several weeks.
